The conference brought together over 180 participants from across Canada to share knowledge, strategies, and inspiration on common areas of interest for educators and families:

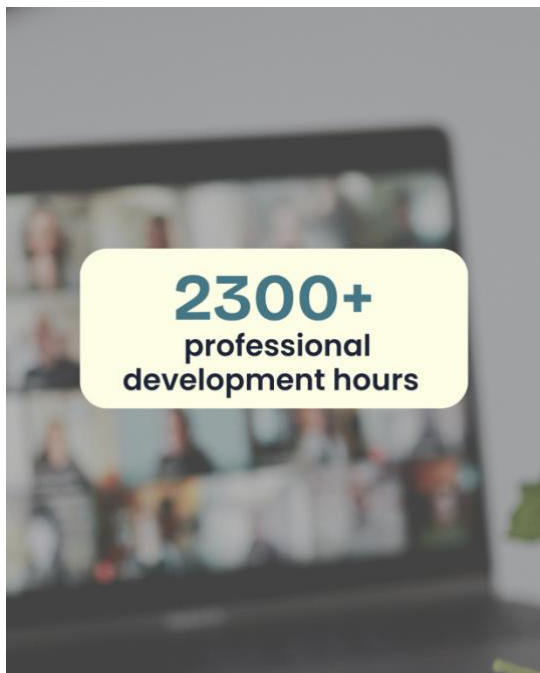
- Understanding assessments,
